## **17th Annual Kittyhawk Post Industry Day "Achieving Resiliency" | Thursday, October 12th**

The SAME Kittyhawk Post's Industry Day event will feature R. Eric Yates, Acquisition Director and Portfolio Manager, US Air Force Office of Energy Assurance (OEA), as their luncheon speaker. Register early to secure your attendance at the luncheon!

The 2017 SAME Kittyhawk Post Industry Day is fast approaching! This year's theme "Achieving Resiliency" will address preparations for energy disruptions that impact mission assurance on military installations. The Department of Defense (DoD) increasingly supports critical time-sensitive national security, warfighting, and life, health, and safety capabilities from its domestic DoD installations. For a majority of these installations, the primary power source to these critical mission operations is the domestic electric grid. Therefore, it is imperative that the critical facilities on these installations are resilient to power outages on the bulk grid. The DoDI (Department of Defense Instruction) defines energy resilience as "The ability to prepare for and recover from energy disruptions that impact mission assurance on military installations." Presenters at this year's program will discuss critical topics to include: MicroGrid Resiliency, Cyber Security, Resiliency Planning to Conception, Critical threats to infrastructure and "NetZero" Facilities.

The event will be held at the Hope Hotel and Conference Center (10823 Chidlaw Rd, Dayton, OH 45433) on Thursday, October 12th, 2017 from 8:00AM to 3:00PM. A networking social will follow at Packy's from 3:00PM to 5:00PM. The October Luncheon Program will run in conjunction with Industry Day.
