

MARY LEFEVRE MEMORIAL EDUCATION AWARD

Annually, the Detroit Post of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) takes great pride in recognizing a distinguished engineering or science student by awarding the Mary LeFevre Memorial Education Award. The Detroit Post SAME is now soliciting nominations for this education award in the amount of \$2000.00.

To be eligible for this education award, the following criteria need be met:

- a. Recipient must be actively employed in a wage-earning position, working at least a part-time schedule (24 or more hours/week) while enrolled in school.
- b. Candidate must be actively enrolled at an accredited college or university within the Detroit Post's AOR (entire state of Michigan and Toledo area)
- c. Candidate must be of sophomore or junior status.
- d. Candidate must be pursuing a bachelor's degree in engineering, architecture, construction management or related sciences.
- e. Candidate must be a United States citizen.

To be considered for this award, the following must be submitted by 31 December:

1. A completed nomination form (attached)
2. A college transcript with cumulative credits and grade point average
3. A letter of recommendation from An SAME Detroit Post member or college advisor. Additional letters from an instructor or immediate supervisor will also be considered.
4. A written submission by the applicant describing scholastic and short term and long term career goals. Replies must be kept to one standard (8 1/2 x 11) page, typed.
5. Proof of U.S. citizenship

Awards will be made to the applicant who by the following criteria has indicated they are the best candidate for success in college or university studies. Points in parenthesis indicate the relative importance of each criterion.

1. Academic record and the nature of the course load (30)
2. Strength of recommendation from SAME member or college advisor (10)
3. Experience in wage-earning or volunteer employment (20)
4. Participation in academic, business, or social organizations, committees, societies, and activities, especially in leadership roles (20)
5. Academic honors and awards (10)
6. Clear expression of goals and career plans in the essay portion of the application (30.) Your essay will be rated on content, grammar, punctuation and spelling.

The student that qualifies for the Mary LeFevre Memorial Education Award will also receive a national SAME student membership through the Detroit Post SAME, in addition to the cash award of \$2000.00. Other financial aid held by the individual recipient will not exclude eligibility.
